



## Functional Areas

- Mission planning for deployed forces

- Supporting Fleets, resource sponsors, and system commands with the development and validation of IAMD requirements
- Leading Navy IAMD concept, doctrine and tactics development and experimentation
- Reviewing and prioritizing experimental IAMD technologies for testing through sea trials
- Promoting rapid delivery of selected new IAMD technologies

With the proliferation of air and missile threats around the world, the capability of the Navy to counter these threats is more important than ever. NAMDC helps focus resources and efforts to maximum effect by acting as the single Navy voice to synchronize and integrate efforts across the full spectrum of air and missile defense. NAMDC also helps ensure that our Navy is well positioned to defend our citizens, our allies, and our interests throughout the world.

We also play a key role in supporting the Navy's effort to execute the President's Phased Adaptive Approach for Ballistic Missile Defense.

This approach deploys proven capabilities to protect our NATO partners, allies and the United States. This includes the current initiative to field Aegis Ashore in Deveselu, Romania. This milestone fielding, will serve a key future role with global missile defense programs.

## Enhancing Navy's Warfighting Capabilities & Readiness

In 2009, the Chief of Naval Operations ordered the formation of Navy Air and Missile Defense Command to serve as the primary authority and lead organization for Naval, joint and coalition integrated air and missile defense, or IAMD.

The command's role is to enhance the Navy's IAMD warfighting capabilities and readiness through interaction with operational and system commands, resource sponsors, developers, Department of Defense agencies, industry and academia.

We are staffed by active duty, government and contract personnel with extensive backgrounds in surface warfare, aviation, intelligence, engineering, applied sciences and integrated air and missile defense expertise.
