NAMDC RECOGNIZES “CONTRACTOR OF THE QUARTER”

(DAHLGREN, VA) -- Navy Air and Missile Defense Command recognized its “Contractor of the Quarter,” during an April 18 awards ceremony.

Mike Poreda, HiPK, who works in the command’s training and assessment division, was recognized for assisting in the development, testing and implementation of the Accelerated Mid-Term Interoperability Improvement Program (AMIIP). AMIIP addresses Fleet war fighting capabilities that have been severely degraded by long-standing, force-wide interoperability issues.

“Mike joined our team just four months ago and he has already made a positive impact on all our programs,” said Rear Admiral M. Stewart O’Bryan.

Since retiring from the Navy in 1996, he has been involved in Test and Evaluation of the Cooperative Engagement Capability, Composite ID system, as well as the development of Multi Tadi Processor, and Area Air Defense Commander prototype.

Poreda is also active with the American Legion and VFW. He is post commander of VFW Post 10574 in Colonial Beach.
